came 1st. Serena Blackwood came in third place in the Year 6 girls' race and Thomas Bickley came 1st in the Year 6 boys' race.

Every member of the team put every ounce of energy into their runs, and that super effort meant we won the overall competition by a huge 214 points.

term, and thank you to all of the parents who helped on the day and came along to cheer our team on.
