As you are probably aware, in October 2015, St. Matthew's was awarded a **Silver level Kite mark for School Games for 2014-15.** We received our pendant and certificate at a presentation at the Cambridge School Sports Partnership network event, held at Comberton Village College, at the start of February. <u>Award Winning Schools</u>: Cambridge Schools being awarded the School Games Mark for 2014-15 in recognition of their commitment to the development of Physical Education, school sport and competition across their school and into the community. The School Games Mark is a Government led awards scheme where schools can gain a bronze, silver or gold level award.

Sporting Competitions

Our **Y5/6 Tag Rugby** team took part in the CSSP Tag Rugby competition on February 29th, at Shelford Rugby Club. 23 teams entered the competition this year and our team won all of their group matches before losing in a close semi-final to Queen Edith's. They recovered quickly to win the third place match to claim the **bronze medals**. Well done to all who took part.

Our A team managed to win their group and defeated Park Street in the Semi-Final. They lost 2-1 to St. Phillip's in a close final to finish up as **Silver Medal winners**. **This means that the team has qualified to represent Cambridge schools at the Cambridgeshire County finals (Level 3 games).** The County finals will be held in St. Ives on Thursday 30th June 2016.

Well done to all of the children who played in the tournament and a big thankyou to Lisa Woolfe, who has been coaching the team in our Tuesday Hockey club.

High Level Coaching at St.Matthew's

This year many of our children will benefit from high level sports coaching from CSSP coaches: our Year 1 classes will receive Tennis coaching from Neil O'Donohue in the Summer term; Year 2 will have Multi sports coaching from Steve Taylor in the Summer term; Year 3 classes will have Gymnastics coaching in the summer term; Year 4 classes have had Netball coaching from Lisa Woolfe last term and Cricket coaching from Steve Taylor this term: Year 5 will have Cricket coaching from Steve Taylor the Add Tag Rugby coaching from Neil O'Donohue.

ARU Sports Students

Our three Year 2 classes have had their PE lessons this half term planned and taught by a group of Sports students from ARU, along with their tutor, Bob Challis. The students have to gain practical coaching experience as part of their courses and as they are already Level 1 or level 2 qualified, our children have benefitted from having high quality coaches to deliver the Games units this term. Each class will have had four lessons taught by 8 sports students this term, alongside their tutor and their class teachers. We intend to continue to develop this valuable link with our close neighbours. Bob Challis and his team will also be providing all of our children with some introductory Judo taster sessions in the summer term.

Cricket at St. Matthew's

We have been very fortunate that during the last ten years the England Cricket Board (ECB) have, through their '**Chance to Shine' initiative**, provided free Cricket coaching to our Year 5 children, in PE Curriculum lessons in the summer term. This year we will once again benefit from this scheme, and **Steve Taylor**, an excellent Cambs Cricket coach, will be teaching our Year 5 classes Kwik Cricket in the summer term. He will also be running our popular Year 5 and 6 Kwik Cricket club after school. Although our curriculum cricket lessons are free we do have to pay for the after school club, however we are using some of our Sports Premium grant to enable this club to remain free to the children. This initiative and the clubs have allowed our children to perform really well at the **Year 5 & 6 cricket festivals**, on Parker's Piece, each June.

Several parents have enquired as to whether Steve will be running a cricket club for younger children, as he did before school last year, but at the moment this will not be possible next term. Our three Year 4 classes also received 6 Curriculum Cricket lessons earlier this term, from Steve, and our current Year 3 children will be taught cricket in year 4 next year.

If there is sufficient demand for additional cricket clubs for our Year3 & 4 children I will look into whether this can be scheduled (in our busy clubs timetable) and costs involved. Please email me (see below) if your child would be interested in attending a cricket club (£2.00 per session)

School Sports Council

McTaggart and Jasmine Pellegrini. Imogen Ransome has been creating the council's agenda and minuting our meetings to ensure everyone knows what has been agreed. The council have been planning and running sporting activities in Golden Time, for Year 3 and 4 children who wish to take part. This has been very popular and the sports vary each week to give the children the opportunity to try different sports. The Sports Council are currently helping to plan our School Sports day in June (see below for details) and organising a big sponsored fundraising event in the Summer Term. Some of our sports council members will be helping Chris Germon next term, at his after school Reception and Year 1-3 multi skills Club.

Our Sports Day will take place on *Thursday 23rd June 2016, on Parker's Piece*. I have been busy gaining permission to hold our event there once again and have been in consultation with the City Council. There will be two events, as in recent years, with our **Reception, Year 1 and 2 classes having their sports day in the morning (9.30 a.m. 11.00 a.m.)** and our KS2 (Y3-6) classes having their sports day in the afternoon (1.30 p.m.- 3.00 p.m.).

Please put this date on your calendar. I will write nearer the time giving more details and asking for volunteers to help with the huge task of setting up this event.

Our Year 5 & 6 sports leaders will be helping run the morning event and we will once again have the help of **Parkside Federation Young Leaders** throughout the day. Thank you, once again to Mr. Dixon and Mr.Thornley at Parkside Federation for allowing us to use their track area and also supporting us in our sports day.
